## Getting Started

1. **Looking for Heroes.** Who was your greatest hero as a child, and why—a teacher, a coach, a youth leader, a sports figure, a comic book or television superhero? Now read the first chapter of Hebrews and explain who ought to be our greatest source of inspiration and why we should actually worship him.

## Getting Into the Bible

2. **The Superiority of His Person.** According to Hebrews 1:1-4, what sets Jesus apart from every other prophet or religious teacher who has ever lived? Name one great religious spokesperson that has impressed you in the past or is drawing attention to himself or herself even today and tell why you believe that Jesus is superior.
3. **The Superiority of His Name.** According to Hebrews 1:4-14, what special name has God given to Jesus? Describe one of the occasions in the gospels when God actually called him by this name. Why does this name make Jesus superior to even the angels of God? How does this help to correct the false claims about Jesus and angels made by many cults and new age teachers?
4. **The Superiority of His Claim.** According to Hebrews 2:1-4, how does the superiority of Jesus make his offer of salvation more sober and serious? To what lengths did he go to purchase our salvation (see 1:3c), and therefore how will God the Father respond to those who ignore his offer and fail to believe in him?

## Getting Personal and Practical

5. **Sharing Your Story.** Have you come to believe in Jesus and worship him as your Lord? If so, take a few moments to describe the spiritual journey that led you to make that decision. If not, share with your group your remaining doubts and ask them to pray for you, that you'll have the faith to believe in Jesus.
