Getting Started

Think back on the history of your small group. In what ways has God called you to be missional as a group? What were some of the benefits of serving together as a small group?

Getting Into the Bible

1) **Read Luke 10:1.** Why did Jesus send the 72 out ahead of Himself? Why kind of qualifications do you think these 72 people had? Is Jesus still sending people out? Who? Read Luke 10:2. What was Jesus' sense of urgency in this verse? Has Jesus' sense of urgency changed in the past 2,000 years?

2) **Read Luke 10:4-8.** What is the contrast between the worker (The one sent out) and the host (The one housing the worker)? What does this say about our lives if we choose to either work or partner with those who are being sent out?

3) **Read Luke 10:9-24.** In 10:11, Jesus refers to Sodom. What happened there? Why did Jesus say a town that rejected his disciples would suffer even more than Sodom? (Genesis 19) And why would it be worse for Korazon and Bethsaida than Tyre and Sidon?

4) **In Luke 10:18-20,** why did Jesus reflect on Satan's fall (See Rev. 12:7-9) and tell His followers "*Do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you?*" (See Proverbs 8:13 & Revelation 3:5) What was it about the disciples report that gave Jesus Joy & Wonder?
