for the week of October 9, 2011**

The Great Confession. Luke 9:18-27

1. There is great power in the right question being asked at the right time and in the right way. Share with the group a question someone asked you that changed the trajectory of your life.
2. If we were to go up and down the streets of Shelton and ask random people, "Who do you say that Jesus is?", what kinds of answers do you think we would hear?
3. Why was it so hard for the disciples to comprehend His clear prophetic teaching about the cross? Do you think Christians today have a hard time accepting what Jesus promised is coming next in His divine plan (i.e., things like the tribulation, the second coming, the judgment seat of Christ, etc)? Why do you think this is so?
4. Rejecting our own plans and will and then taking up our own cross daily seems pretty heavy and negative to some. Look at verses 34 - 38 and describe the "up side" of such radical obedience.
5. Describe a situation where God has asked you to answer in a fresh way, "Who do you say that I am"?
