## EASTER'S COMING

Easter comes really late this year. In fact, it's about the latest possible date for Easter. It won't be on April 24 again until the year 2095. And the latest it can ever fall on the calendar is April 25. That happened in 1943, and will happen again in 2038, if the Lord hasn't returned by then.

It strikes me that here at FBC, it's somehow appropriate that Easter comes so late this year. It seems like we've been in a long season of waiting for new life to appear. For many there's been a lot of struggle, pain, and at least figuratively speaking, the death of some of our ideals about the church and congregational family life. It seems like a resurrection is long overdue.

Well, it's late, but I know it's coming.

## HOW CAN I BE SO SURE?

*"And since we died with Christ, we know we will also share in his new life. We are sure of this because Christ rose from the dead, and he will never die again. Death has no power over him. He died once to defeat sin, and now he lives for the glory of God. So you should consider yourselves dead to sin and able to live for the glory of God through Christ Jesus." Romans 6: 8-11, NLT (underlines added).*

I'm so sure because these verses remind us who we really are.

We are, by Christ's power, able to consider ourselves "dead to sin".  
We are also "able to live for the glory of God through Christ Jesus".

Do we always live up to our potential? I know I don't. But the resurrection power of Christ is still just as real. Christ rose from the dead, and that truth is what defines our potential, who we really are, now that we belong to Him.

Clearly our failures, individually and corporately, to live up to the potential that is ours in Christ, don't change the truth of Christ's historic resurrection. In the same way, they do not change the power we have available to us to live for God's glory, because that power is rooted in the historic fact of Christ's resurrection. And that's why Easter means so much to those who have come to Christ for mercy.
