All Extra Proceeds will go toward our FBC Building Fund.



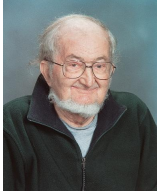

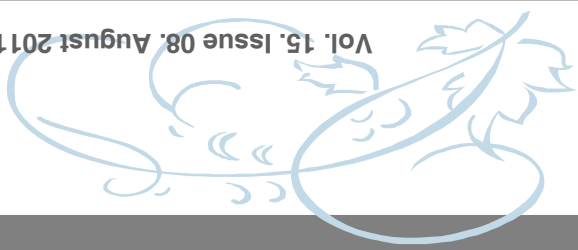
